

2018 AggieFest LDE Invitational

Hosted by Texas A&M University-Future Agricultural Science Teachers (FAST) in conjunction with Texas A&M University-CFFA

FAST will host our annual invitational Leadership Development Event on **Saturday, November 3, 2018**. Entries are open to all Texas FFA Chapters. Pre-registration fees are \$20 per team for team events and \$10 per individual for individual events (Creed, Quiz, Job Interview) if entries are made by Tuesday, October 30. Late entries will be taken only as room/time permits at a fee of \$30 per team and \$15 per individual. State rules, including official dress, will be followed.

We will begin **check-in at 7:30 a.m. on November 3** in the foyer of the **Ag. and Life Sciences Building (AGLS Bldg.)** on the Texas A&M University campus. Events will begin **at 8:00 a.m.**
